

ASC Ice Show 2008 - 'Hooray for Hollywood'

DRESS REHEARSAL INFORMATION

- Where:** Aurora Community Centre #1, Aurora Heights Drive
- When:** Friday, April 4, 2008, 4:00 p.m.
- Times:** Please note: Arrival/Departure times for Canskaters vary depending on whether they are in the first or second half of the show.
- 1st Half:** Canskate Groups # 1, 2, 4, 10, 11, 12, and 14
Arrive: 4:00 p.m. Pick up: 6:15 p.m.
- 2nd Half:** Canskate Groups # 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 13
Arrive: 6:00 p.m. Pick up: 8:30 p.m.
- Duration:** All Junior, Novice, Senior and Advanced Skaters are to arrive at 4:00 p.m. and remain for the duration of the dress rehearsal until 8:30 p.m.

How do I know what show number my skater is in?

Your skater's group show number is posted on the Bulletin Board and the club website. If you are unsure of your child's show number assignment, please ask.

When and where do I bring my child for dress rehearsal?

Please see drop off and pickup times listed above.

Bring your skater to the Main Lobby entrance located between ACC#1 and ACC#2. He/she will be escorted to the appropriate dressing room. Volunteer dressing room parents are assigned to each group. The children are supervised at all times. This is a closed rehearsal. No parents (other than dress rehearsal volunteers) or spectators are permitted to remain at dress rehearsal.

What should I send with my child?

Skates and skate guards, hair brush/comb, hair ties, snack, and drink (please NO peanut products, glass bottles or pop). DO NOT SEND MONEY OR ELECTRONIC GAMES. The children will not be allowed to purchase food at the snack bar. Your child should be suitably dressed for his/her costume and have a warm coat as they will be sitting in the stands during rehearsal when not on the ice. All girls are to wear beige tights with their costumes, which are NOT provided.

What happens at dress rehearsal?

Volunteer dressing room parents assist the children into their costumes and skates. The children participate in a full run through of the show. A professional photographer will be taking an individual and group photographs of your child in full costume. The costume remains at the arena in the dressing room. The children are not permitted to take the costume home.

Does my child wear make up?

For hygienic reasons we do not apply make up on the children. However, parents may choose to apply suitable lip-gloss/lipstick, blush, and eye shadow, at their discretion at home.

Please note: Only those parents who have received a volunteer assignment are permitted to remain at dress rehearsal. Children are supervised at all times. Security guards will be on site.

ADDITIONAL ICE SHOW INFORMATION

Where: Aurora Community Centre #1, Aurora Heights Drive

When: Saturday, April 5, 2008, 1:00 p.m. Matinee and 7:00 p.m. Evening

Matinee: Drop off Child in main lobby at 12:15p.m.
Pick-up Child from dressing room immediately after show.

Evening: Drop off Child in main lobby at 6:15p.m.
Pick-up Child from dressing room immediately after show.

Please note: Skaters and show volunteers check in at the Main Lobby entrance (between ACC#2 and ACC#1) approximately 45 minutes before show time. No other persons will be permitted past the check-in point. Children perform in both shows and participate in the Grand Finale at the end of each show. Parents must pick up and sign out their children from the Dressing Room area immediately after the end of each show. Security will be on site during both shows.

Parents and spectators attending the show and not requiring use of the elevator must enter via the ticketed seats entrance at ACC#1.
