Dr. Lawrence St. Pierre received his DDS from U. of Toronto 1975 using the Canadian Forces Dental Officer Training Plan. He completed Specialty Training through the US Army in Prosthodontics in 1982 and was an Instructor at Canadian Forces Dental Services School Base Borden 1982 – 1986. He has been in private practice in Barrie since 1982. Dr. St. Pierre is known by his colleagues as a practical prosthodontist, a MacGyver type dentist who will use innovation to “fix” the seemingly hopeless dental cripples with prosthodontic solutions at a reasonable price. His implant experience dates from his specialty training exposure and the early days of private practice. Now, after twenty plus years of both placing and restoring dental implants, he has a lot of useful information to share with the less experienced. Others in his specialty used to criticize him for placing his own implants, and for doing flapless surgery years before it became accepted. With over 20 years of implant experience also comes the heartache of failures and it is his wish to share these “learning opportunities” with others in the hope of preventing them from falling into the same pitfalls.
